ORDER

On 17 January 2025, Cebu I Electric Cooperative, Inc. (CEBECO I) and KEPCO SPC Power Corporation (KSPC) filed a *Joint Application*, dated 11 September 2024, seeking the Commission’s approval of their Power Supply Agreement (PSA), with prayer for confidential treatment of information and motion for provisional authority.

The pertinent allegations of the *Joint Application* are hereunder quoted as follows:

THE APPLICANTS

1. Applicant CEBU I Electric Cooperative (CEBECO I for brevity) is an Electric Cooperative created and existing pursuant to the provisions of Presidential Decree No. 269 as amended, with principal office located at Bito-on, Dumanjug, Cebu,

Philippines, represented herein by its General Manager, Engr. Getulio Z. Crodua, duly authorized by virtue of Resolution No. 122, Series of 2024 dated 13 July 2024 of the Board of Directors, copy of which is attached hereto as Annex “A” and made an integral part hereof.

The filing of the instant Application is likewise authorized under the afore-cited Board Resolution.

2. Applicant KEPCO SPC Power Corporation (“KSPC”) is a corporation duly organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the Republic of the Philippines, with principal address at the 7th Floor, Cebu Holdings Center, Cebu Business Park, Cebu City, Philippines, herein represented by its Senior Marketing Manager, Hongseon Park, who has been authorized by its Board of Directors to file the Joint Application as evidenced by the Secretary’s Certificate dated February 28, 2024, attached hereto as *Annex “B”*.
3. Applicant KSPC owns and operates a 2x103 MW Circulating Fluidized Bed Combustor (CFBC) Boiler Coal-Fired base load power plant in the City of Naga, Cebu, which became operational in 2011.
4. Applicants may be served notices, orders, and other processes of the Honorable Commission through their respective counsels at their addresses indicated below.

NATURE OF THE APPLICATION

5. This is an application for the approval of the Power Sales Agreement (“PSA”) between CEBECO I and KSPC executed on July 03, 2024. A copy of the PSA is attached hereto as *Annex “C”*.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

6. Applicant has been granted by the National Electrification Administration (NEA) an authority to operate and distribute electric light and power within the coverage area comprising the City of Carcar and the Municipalities of Barili, Dumanjug, Ronda, Alcantara, Moalboal, Badian, Alegria, Malabuyoc, Ginatilan, Samboan, Santander, Sibonga, Argao, Dalaguete, Alcoy, Boljo-on, and Oslob, all in the Province of Cebu.
7. In the course of its electric power distribution mandate, CEBECO I entered into Power Supply Contracts with Generation Companies in such volume consistent with the supply demand profile as provided in its Power Supply Procurement Plan (PSPP).
8. With the expiration of CEBECO I’s Power Supply Contract with one of its suppliers, CEBECO I shall suffer a supply shortfall of Eleven (11MW) megawatt.

THE COMPETITIVE SELECTION PROCESS

9. In order to remedy the situation, CEBECO I shall procure the needed supply from a reputable and reliable generation company, which procurement shall be undertaken through a Competitive Selection Process pursuant to the Department of Energy Department Circular No. DC2018-02-0003, as amended by DC 2021-09-0030 entitled *“Adopting and Prescribing the Policy for the Competitive Selection Process in the Procurement by the Distribution Utilities of Power Supply Agreement for the Captive Market*, which Department Circular is the prevailing CSP Guidelines at the time of procurement.
10. On 19 July 2023, the Department of Energy, in a letter to NEA, confirmed that CEBECO I’s Terms of Reference (TOR) is consistent with the EC’s 2023-2032 Power Supply Procurement Plan. The Department, in the same letter advised the NEA to issue the Notice to Proceed (NTP) for the publication of the Invitation to Bid along with the TOR. On 3 August 2023, the NEA then issued the NTP directing CEBECO I to publish the Invitation to Bid and its Terms of Reference in a newspaper of general circulation.
11. Following the aforesaid CSP Guidelines, CEBECO I conducted the pre-bid conference on 06 September 2023 with the participation of two (2) prospective bidders who have expressed interest in participating in the CSP, namely: KEPCO SPC Power Corporation and FDC Misamis Power Corporation. During the Bid Opening on 07 November 2023, both bidders were declared eligible and proceeded with the opening of the bid proposals.
12. After the bid opening on 07 November 2023, the TPBAC and the TWG conducted the Post Qualification Process in order to further evaluate and make a thorough assessment of the Bid Proposals submitted by the two (2) eligible bidders. The post qualification evaluation shows that KEPCO SPC POWER CORPORATION tendered the Lowest Calculated and Most Responsive Bid. Accordingly the TPBAC recommended the KSPC as the winning bidder.
13. After a careful deliberation, the CEBECO I Board of Directors in its Board Resolution No. 183, series of 2023 dated 25 November 2023 approved the recommendation of the TPBAC and declared KSPC as the winning bidder. Consequently, the TPBAC issued a Notice of Award to KSPC on 01 December 2023.
14. Thereafter, having complied with the CSP Guidelines and submission of all relevant documents on the conduct of CSP, the NEA issued a Notice to Proceed with the execution and signing of the power supply agreement between CEBECO I and KSPC on 14 June 2024.

15. Details of the Conduct of the Competitive Selection Process including all correspondence, approval letters and certifications from the DOE and NEA, all pertinent Board Resolutions issued by the CEBECO I Board of Directors and TPBAC Resolutions issued by the CEBECO I TPBAC is attached hereto as Annex “D”.
16. Consequently, CEBECO I and KSPC executed a Power Supply Agreement (“PSA”) on July 03, 2024, and thus, this instant Joint Application is before this Honorable Commission for the approval of the aforesaid PSA.

SALIENT FEATURES OF THE PSA

17. Salient Features of the PSA.
 - a. Contract Quantity. Upon the terms and subject to the condition set out herein, commencing on the Delivery date and until the Termination Date, the seller shall deliver or cause the delivery to the buyer, and the buyer shall pay for, in each Contract year, a minimum number in kWh of energy, as set forth in schedule two.
 - b. KSPC Capacity Cap means 11,000 kW
 - c. Contract Year means any successive 12-month period commencing on the Effective date.
 - d. Effective Date. Subject to Article 3.2, upon the satisfaction by the parties of all corporate approvals and government authorities, this Agreement shall take effect immediately upon the execution date. It shall be understood however, that ten (10) year term shall commence on the Delivery Date herein defined, and shall remain in force and effect unless pre- terminated by either parties in accordance with the termination provision.
 - i. Article 3.2. Upon receipt of the approval of this Agreement or the issuance of the provisional authority by the Energy Regulatory Commission (ERC), the obligation of the seller to supply and deliver the Contracted Capacity shall commence on the date specified on the initial “Day Ahead Nomination” issued by the buyer and duly received by the Seller.
 - e. Delivery Date means the date of the start of supply of power
 - f. Replacement Power shall mean power supplied to the Buyer when the Cebu Power Plant is in Forced/ Planned outage.

- g. KSPC Price means the base rate which is 5.7523 PHP/kWh

INDICATIVE RATE IMPACT ON CEBECO I’s GENERATION
RATE

18. In a Rate Impact Analysis conducted by co-applicant CEBECO I, a significant decrease in its rates is observed as shown hereunder, to wit:

20. Certificate of Compliance. The Honorable Commission has issued the Certificate of Compliance (“COC”) with COC no. 24-03-M-00068V dated 26 March 2024, for KSPC’s power plants. A copy of the COC is attached as *Annex “G”*.

The DOE has issued a Certificate of Endorsement with No. 2022-04-160 dated 19 April 2022 for KSPC’s plant in barangay Colon, Naga City, Cebu, certifying that the Plant is consistent with the Power Development Plan of the Government. A copy of the Certificate of endorsement is hereto attached as *Annex “H”*.
22. **ALLEGATIONS IN SUPPORT OF THE MOTION
FOR CONFIDENTIAL TREATMENT OF INFORMATION**

23. Prior to the tendering phase in the Competitive Selection Process conducted by co-applicant CEBECO I, KSPC desirous to participate and to submit its bid, conducted studies, simulations, market sensitivity analysis and the like procedures in order to establish a reasonably competitive power cost beneficial to CEBECO I and its captive market.

While the computed cost may be based on data publicly obtainable, yet the process in arriving at a fairly reasonable cost remains a property of co-applicant KSPC, and deemed confidential in nature.

24. In the event this data, information and procedures fall into the hands of its competitors, KSPC will be prejudiced and left disadvantaged; thus to prevent such prejudicial eventuality, it is only appropriate and rational that this information and relevant data and procedure be protected and remained for the Commission’s reference only.
25. It may be of interest to note that no less than the ERC’s Rules of Practice and Procedures offers a guarantee for the continued confidentiality of these information, data and procedures in order to protect the interest of co-applicant KEPCO, which pertinent provision is hereunder quoted as follows, to wit:

“Section 1, Rule 4, of the ERC Revised Rules of Practice and Procedure provides that a party to a proceeding before the Honorable Commission may move for information to be treated as confidential;”

26. Availing of this provision, KSPC sought to be treated confidentially the following documents and information as they contain trade secrets and/or commercially sensitive data pertaining to KEPCO’s plant operation and pricing strategies:

**ALLEGATIONS IN SUPPORT OF THE MOTION FOR
PROVISIONAL AUTHORITY**

27. CEBECO I and KSPC replead, and incorporates by reference, all the foregoing allegations, and further state that:
- 27.a. As discussed earlier, CEBECO I shall suffer a power supply shortfall by 11MW with the expiry of the PSA with one of its power suppliers and the EPSA;

- 27.b. The power supply deficit aforementioned if remained unremedied may result in power unreliability considering that any distribution utility without a bilateral contract runs the risk of prioritized load dropping in the event the Grid will suffer an insufficient supply of power, to the detriment of the economy and welfare of the residents in the franchise area of CEBECO I;
- 27.c. In order to prevent the occurrence of such unfavorable and disadvantageous situation, which, is already deemed imminent, applicants are faced with no other recourse except to pray for the issuance of a provisional authority, pending evaluation and consideration of this application, as provided under *Section 1, Rule 14* of the *ERC Revised Rules of Practice and Procedure*, which for immediate reference is hereunder quoted as follows, to wit:

“Section 1. Provisional Authority or Interim Relief. – *For applications or petitions covered by Section 1, Rule 6 of these Rules, the Commission may grant either a provisional authority or an interim relief, upon motion included in the application or petition and indicated in the caption thereof that such relief is requested x x x.*”

28. In support of the prayer for provisional authority, an Affidavit of Merit executed by the General Manager of CEBECO I, Engr. Getulio Z. Crodua, and attached herewith as *Annex “NN”*.

PRAYER

WHEREFORE, foregoing premises considered, it is most respectfully prayed of the Honorable Commission: That –

1. Upon initial review of this Application and pending hearing on the merits, issue an Order granting PROVISIONAL APPROVAL of the PSA; thereby (i) authorizing KSPC to deliver such volume of electricity nominated by CEBECO I; (ii) authorizing KSPC to charge and collect from CEBECO I electricity fees based on rates that this Honorable Commission may provisionally approve; and (iii) authorizing CEBECO I to pass the full amount thereof to its customers;
2. An Order be issued granting Co-applicant KSPC’s Motion for the Issuance of an Order:
 - a. Treating the Confidential Documents and the information contained therein as confidential
 - b. Directing their non-disclosure pursuant to Rule 4 of the ERC Rules, and

- c. Prescribing guidelines for the protection of the said documents.
- 3. After trial on the merits, issue a Decision approving the PSA with Finality, thereby (i) confirming the compliance by CEBECO I and KSPC to the rules governing power supply; and (ii) further confirming the effective rate charged, collected, and paid in connection with this PSA; and (iii) to authorize KSPC to charge and collect from CEBECO I the electricity fees based on the final rates approved by this Honorable Commission; and (iv) authorizing CEBECO I to pass to and collect the full amount thereof to its customers.

Other relief and remedies consistent with law, justice, and equity are likewise prayed for.

Finding the said *Joint Application* to be sufficient in form and with the required fees having been paid, the Commission hereby sets the same for hearing for determination of compliance with the jurisdictional requirements, expository presentation, Pre-Trial Conference and presentation of evidence on the following dates and online platforms for the conduct thereof, pursuant to Resolution No. 09, Series of 2020¹ and Resolution No. 01, Series of 2021² (ERC Revised Rules of Practice and Procedure):

Accordingly, CEBECO I and KSPC are hereby directed to mirror the virtual hearings to be hosted by the Commission at **CEBECO I's principal office located at Bito-on, Damanjug, Cebu**, as the designated venue for the conduct thereof and ensure that the same is open to the public. Moreover, CEBECO I and KSPC shall guarantee

that, during the conduct of the expository presentation, the participation of the public shall not be impaired.

RELATIVE THERETO, CEBECO I and KSPC are hereby directed to:

- 1) Cause the publication of the attached *Notice of Virtual Hearing* in two (2) newspapers of nationwide circulation in the Philippines at its own expense twice (2x) within two (2) successive weeks, the dates of publication not being less than seven (7) days apart, and the date of the last publication to be made not later than ten (10) days before the date of the scheduled initial virtual hearing;
- 2) Furnish with copies of this *Order* and the attached *Notice of Virtual Hearing* the Offices of the Governor, the Mayors, and their respective Local Government Unit (LGU) legislative bodies within CEBECO I's franchise area for the appropriate posting thereof on their respective bulletin boards;
- 3) Inform the consumers within CEBECO I's franchise area, by any other means available and appropriate, of the filing of the *Joint Application*, its reasons therefor, and of the scheduled virtual hearings thereon;
- 4) Furnish with copies of this *Order* and the attached *Notice of Virtual Hearing*, the Office of the Solicitor General (OSG), the Commission on Audit (COA), and the Committees on Energy of both Houses of Congress. They are hereby requested, if they so desire, to send their duly authorized representatives and attend the scheduled hearings; and
- 5) Furnish with copies of the *Joint Application* and its attachments, except those subject of a motion for confidential treatment of information, all those making requests therefor, subject to reimbursement of reasonable photocopying costs.

Within five (5) calendar days prior to the date of the initial virtual hearing, CEBECO I and KSPC must submit to the Commission via electronic mail (e-mail) at docket@erc.ph, and copy furnish the Legal Service through legal@erc.ph, the scanned copies of their written

compliance with the aforementioned jurisdictional requirements, attaching the following methodically arranged and duly marked documents:

- 1) The evidence of publication of the attached *Notice of Virtual Hearing* consisting of affidavits of the Editors or Business Managers of the newspaper where the said *Notice of Virtual Hearing* was published, and the complete issues of the said newspapers;
- 2) The evidence of actual posting of this *Order* and the attached *Notice of Virtual Hearing* consisting of certifications issued to that effect, signed by the aforementioned Governor, Mayors and LGU legislative bodies or their duly authorized representatives, bearing the seals of their offices;
- 3) The evidence of other means employed by CEBECO I and KSPC to inform the consumers within CEBECO I's franchise area of the filing of the *Joint Application*, their reasons therefor, and of the scheduled hearings thereon;
- 4) The evidence of receipt of copies of this *Order* and the attached *Notice of Virtual Hearing* by the OSG, the COA, and the Committees on Energy of both Houses of Congress;
- 5) The evidence of receipt of copies of the *Application* and its attachments, except those subject of a motion for confidential treatment of information, if any, by all those making requests therefor; and
- 6) Such other proof of compliance with the requirements of the Commission.

Moreover, CEBECO I and KSPC are hereby required to post on their bulletin boards, the scanned copies of the foregoing jurisdictional requirements, together with the newspaper publications and certifications issued by the concerned Offices of the Governor, Mayors and Local Legislative Bodies, and to submit proof of posting thereof.

Applicants CEBECO I and KSPC, and all interested parties are also required to submit via e-mail at docket@erc.ph, and copy furnish the Legal Service through legal@erc.ph, **at least five (5) calendar**

days before the date of the scheduled virtual hearing and Pre-trial Conference, their respective Pre-Trial Briefs containing, among others:

- 1) A summary of admitted facts and proposed stipulation of facts;
- 2) The issues to be tried or resolved;
- 3) The documents or exhibits to be presented, stating the purposes and proposed markings thereof, which should also be attached to the Pre-Trial Brief; and
- 4) The number and names of the witnesses, with their written testimonies in a Judicial Affidavit from attached to the Pre-Trial Brief.

Applicants CEBECO I and KSPC must ensure that all the documents or exhibits proposed to be presented have already been duly submitted to the Commission **at least five (5) calendar days** before the date of the scheduled virtual hearing and Pre-trial Conference pursuant to the preceding paragraph.

Failure of CEBECO I and KSPC to comply with the above requirements within the prescribed period shall be a ground for cancellation of the scheduled hearings.

Applicants CEBECO I and KSPC must also be prepared to make an expository presentation of the instant *Joint Application*, aided by whatever communication medium that they may deem appropriate for the purpose, in order to put in plain words and explain, for the benefit of the consumers and other concerned parties, the nature of the *Joint Application*. Relevant information and pertinent details substantiating the reasons and justifications for the *Joint Application* must be cited in support thereof.

Applicants CEBECO I and KSPC are hereby directed to file a copy of their Expository Presentation via e-mail at docket@erc.ph, copy furnish the Legal Service through legal@erc.ph, **at least five (5) calendar days** prior to the scheduled virtual hearing. CEBECO I and KSPC shall also be required, upon the request of any stakeholder, to provide an advance copy of their Expository Presentation, **at least five (5) calendar days** prior to the scheduled virtual hearing.

Applicants CEBECO I and KSPC are hereby directed to submit, through personal service, registered mail or ordinary mail/private courier, one (1) set of the original or certified true hard copies of their Jurisdictional Compliance, Expository Presentation, Pre-Trial Brief, and Judicial Affidavits of witnesses, **within five (5) working days** from the date that the same were electronically submitted, as reflected in the acknowledgement receipt e-mail sent by the Commission.

Finally, CEBECO I and KSPC, including their authorized representatives and witnesses, are hereby directed to provide the Commission, through legal.virtualhearings@erc.ph, their respective e-mail addresses upon receipt of this *Order*. The Commission will send the access link/s to the aforementioned hearing platform within five (5) working days prior to the scheduled hearing.
